Community Resource	Description of Offerings
Aid to Victims of Domestic Violence	Aid to Victims of Domestic Abuse provides services for those suffering from dating violence.
AirCheck Texas, H-GAC	Helps clients comply with emissions standards by offering financial assistance to repair or replace older, polluting vehicles (cars and trucks). Provide education literature, and give away promotional materials regarding services and resources available to them and their families.
Alliance for Multicultural Community Services	The Alliance for Multicultural Community Services offers ESL classes, vocational trainings (CNA, AutoCAD, Pipe Design and General Office Support Specialist) as well as SBA loans, financial and employment coaching and income support (SNAP renewal, Medicaid and Medicare application assistance, etc).
Amerigroup	Provides chip Medicaid information.
Avenue 360 formerly Houston Area Community Services	Services include medical care, housing, pharmacy, medical case management, dental, HIV testing and much more.
Baker Ripley, formerly Neighborhood Center	Provides career coaching including job readiness, career interest profile, short term training opportunities, on the job training opportunities and job placement service.
Baker Ripley/ ASPIRE program	Provides training information about higher wage opportunities in health care and middle skilled industrial trades.
BB&T	Offers financial education and our financial wellness program to students on topics related to banking and saving/budgeting.
Bella Dental	Offers FREE Dental Screenings
Catholic Charities	Assists with shelter, rent and or mortgage assistance and career planning.
Chinese Community Center	Offers vocation training programs, financial opportunity center, ESL and citizenship programs.
City of Houston WIC Program	Assists with setting up WIC appointments if needed and provides nutrition information.
City of Houston, Bureau of Community & Children's Environmental Health	Responds to complaints regarding childhood lead poisoning, indoor air quality, occupational health, medical waste, radiation compliance and smoking.
Dispute Resolution	Provides information on free mediation.

Fort Bend Habitat for Humanity	Offers affordable housing; critical repairs and Fort Bend Habitat for Humanity ReStore.
Goodwill Heights JOB Connection	The Goodwill Heights Job Connection is a "Workforce Development Program," offering job readiness training, to individuals who are unemployed or underemployed. Literature will be provided about the three-day session, which includes job search preparation, presentation coaching, mock interviewing, resume construction, personalized job leads, placement assistance, and a financial literacy component.
Goodwill Houston	Offers various programs and services available throughout the Houston area.
Goodwill Houston's Veteran Services	Will provide information to all veteran clients concerning employment services and homeless veteran programs.
Goodwill Industries of Houston	Will offer application intake for SNAP, Job Connection Service Centers and Vocational Training (CAMT- Certified Apartment Maintenance Technician) 9 week free course
Gulf Coast Community Services Association	Will be on-site to share information about services.
Harris Health	Offers healthcare services and health education.
HCC Continuing Education & Outreach Svcs	Offers "zero-cost" apprenticeship program from the American Apprenticeship Initiative Grant – a partnership between CVS Health and HCC to recruit students for the Pharmacy Technician Apprenticeship program.
Houston Health Department	The Houston Health Department promotes the Healthy Texas Women (HTW) free health care to women between 15-44 years of age. We assist female students with no health care insurance to enroll for this State funded program where they can receive health care for free anywhere in the state of Texas. We fill out paperwork for students on the spot (2-4 minutes) and send to the State for approval. Eligibility criteria is: have no health insurance, not be pregnant, and be a US citizen or legal resident. Services include: Contraceptive, pelvic examinations, STI's, breast and cervical cancer screenings, clinical breast examinations, cholesterol, diabetes, & high blood pressure screening along with care and treatment (medication provided), mental health, and much more all for free.
Houston Public Library	Will provide FREE Library Cards
Maximus	Provides application intake for Medicaid.

MCNA Dental	Provides oral healthcare information and free dental kits.
Nightlight Pediatric Urgent Care	Provides information on pediatric urgent care and urgency versus emergency.
Nurse Family Partnership	Will be on-site to share information about services.
Office of the Attorney General/CSD	Provides information about establishing paternity and child support court orders. It also supports victims of crimes to help compensate for issues associated to that crime – for example, loss of wages, funeral costs, relocation fees and medical costs.
Santa Maria Hostel	Provides prevention and intervention information on Women's Issues such as substance abuse disorder, pregnancy, parenting and HIV.
Spring Branch Community Health Center	Offers healthcare services and health education.
Star of Hope	Will be on-site to share information about services.
Summit Dental Center	Will be on-site to share information about services.
Texas Children's Health Plan	Provide information about the benefits that Texas Children's Health Plan available to families that have apply for Medicaid, CHIP and Star Kids.
The Salvation Army	Will be on-site to share information about services.
The WorkFaith Connection	The WorkFaith Connection provides an 8-Day job readiness program to equip participants for a successful job search. Once a graduate of our program you have access to all of our community partners for things like additional training.

University of Houston- College of Nursing	Offers transcript evaluations for those who are interested/eligible in pursuing their nursing careers at the University of Houston College of Nursing.
Weekley Family YMCA Outreach	Provides information on youth programs, YMCA memberships, swim lessons, sports, and volunteering opportunities.
